

## Pastoral Care Worker

The Pastoral Care Worker at Loxton Primary School provides pastoral support to students, staff and parents, and links families to community resources and services.

Chaplaincy Services promote student wellbeing, by engaging young people in activities that are preventative and which support early intervention and positive mental health.

- Pastoral Care Workers (PCW), previously known as Chaplains, have been working in South Australian Government Schools for a number of years.
- There is a partnership between the local Christian churches and the school for employing the PCW, coordinated by Schools Ministry Group (SMG).
- The PCW is police checked and line managed within the school.
- Students must have informed written consent before obtaining individual and personal assistance from the school's Pastoral Care Worker.
