

Thank you to our parents who are entering the site at pick up and drop off times for being respectful and mindful of maintaining the Health advice of 1.5m Social Distance between adults and also for not entering classrooms. The system of parents needing to meet staff booking through the Front Office is working well and we appreciate your ongoing support of our COVID restrictions.

Last week, we were thrilled to be able to host our first Assembly at LPS, since the beginning of the year. It was fantastic to reconnect our whole school together again for the first time in a long time. Our Student Leaders talked about how they have been supporting our students, Play Pal Leaders discussed the Play Pal role and our Year 7 Activity Leaders talked about the lunch time activities they are running to support our students.

We watched a video created by 5AH, reminding us all to use the correct bins for our rubbish and recycling. Some students and classes were recognised for their fantastic work demonstrating our School Values and Mrs Gibbs got us all moving and grooving with the introduction of 'Assembly Activities'. It was great to have our whole school back together again and we hope to be able to invite our school community to join us again in the near future.

Yesterday, we had the privilege of a visit from the Honorable John Gardner MP, Minister for Education. He was joined by Tim Whetstone - Member for Chaffey, some advisors and the Education Director from the Berri Portfolio, Mr Con Karvouniaris. 


